After discussion, the Secretary has expressed her deep concern over the increase in the fees structure for the existing PG courses and felt that in view of the conduct of online courses and COVID 19 pandemic throughout the country and suggested that a 5 percent increase may be given from the existing fee structure in respect of all M.A., M.Sc., Mathematics and Applied Psychology for the Academic Year 2021-22 and if the country comes out of the COVID pandemic then the increase may be considered from the next Academic Year 2022-23. The Chairperson has also agreed for the suggestion of the Secretary.

The council approved the proposed Fees Structure for all new M.Sc., Computer Science Post Graduate programmes to be offered from the Academic Year 2021-22.


