SPOT ADMISSION NOTIFICATION

The RGNIYD invites aspiring candidates to participate in the Spot Admission process on **14 July 2026** for vacant seats in various Post Graduate (PG) programmes for the Academic Year 2026–27.

Selection will be based on a **Written Examination** followed by an **Interview**. Eligible candidates are invited to appear for the admission process for the following PG programmes offered by RGNIYD, Sriperumbudur:

1. M.Sc. Applied Psychology
2. M.A. Development Studies
3. M.A. English
4. M.A. Public Administration
5. MSW Youth and Community Development
6. M.A. Sociology

The Written Examination and Interview will be conducted **only in offline (physical) mode** on **14 July 2026** at the following centres:

- **RGNIYD, Sriperumbudur** (where the programmes are offered), and
- **RGNIYD Regional Centre, Chandigarh**
- **Rajiv Gandhi University, (RGNIYD Regional Centre N-E) Arunachal Pradesh**

Candidates must appear in person at any one of the designated centres to participate in the selection process.

As this is the final opportunity for admission, candidates who are unable to register online may also attend the Spot Admission.

Instructions for Reporting to the Entrance Test

Candidates seeking admission through the Spot Admission process must report at **8:00 AM on 14 July 2026**.

All interested candidates are required to bring the following **original documents** along with one set of self-attested photocopies and two passport-size photographs:

- UG mark sheets and Degree Certificate
- Category Certificate (if applicable)
- Class XII Mark Sheet
- Class X Mark Sheet
- Transfer Certificate (TC)
- Migration Certificate

(Note: If the T.C / M.C or Degree Certificates are not obtained from the last studied Colleges / Universities, the same may be submitted later but not beyond one month from the date of admission)

Document verification will be conducted from **8:15 AM to 9:30 AM** in the respective departments. Only candidates whose documents are successfully verified and found eligible will be permitted to appear for the **Written Entrance Test**.

Entrance Test

The **Written Entrance Test** will be conducted from **10:30 AM to 12:30 PM**.

The examination will comprise:

- **70 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs)**, and
- **3 Subjective Questions**,

covering the core subjects relevant to the programme applied for, along with General Knowledge and Logical Reasoning.

There will be no negative marking. The standard of the entrance test will be at the undergraduate (UG) level for the respective programme to which the candidate has applied.

The results of the Written Entrance Test will be announced on the same day. Shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend the Interview.

Tie-Breaking Criteria

In the event of a tie in the Entrance Test scores, the order of merit will be determined based on the following criteria:

1. CGPA/Percentage obtained in the qualifying Undergraduate (UG) Degree.
2. Date of Birth, with preference determined as per the Institute's admission rules.

Interview

The **Interview** will be conducted on the **same day**, commencing at **2:00 PM** in the respective departments.

Candidates shortlisted based on the Written Entrance Test will be required to appear for the Interview. Upon completion of the interview, candidates may leave the campus.

The **final selection list** is expected to be published either on the **same day** or on the **following day**.

General Instructions

- Appearance for the Spot Admission process does **not** guarantee admission. Candidates must report in person for document verification and subsequently appear for the Written Entrance Test and interview to be considered for admission. Interested candidates are required to report at their own interest.
- The **programme-wise and category-wise vacancy position** will be notified on the Institute's website.
- The number of vacant seats is **provisional** and may change due to cancellation of admissions or revision of the admission category.
- For detailed information on eligibility criteria, programme details, reservation policy, and admission fees, candidates are advised to refer to the RGNIYD Prospectus available on the Institute's website.
- Candidates who are offered admission must complete all admission formalities, including fee payment (only through online mode), within the stipulated deadline for the respective admission round. Failure to do so will result in cancellation of the admission offer, and the vacant seat will be allotted to the next eligible candidate in the order of merit.
- Any form of canvassing or influence to secure admission through any channel will lead to rejection of the application and/or disqualification of the candidate.
- If any discrepancy is found between the information furnished in the application and the supporting documents submitted, the Institute reserves the right to cancel the admission at any stage.
- Admission is liable to be cancelled or suspended if a candidate:
 - Does not fulfil the prescribed eligibility criteria;
 - Has secured admission through fraudulent means; or
 - Has furnished false, misleading, or incorrect information in the application form.
