Dean (Academic)

The Dean (Academic) shall be in-charge of all academic programmes; the introduction of new programme / courses; Entering into MoU with Institutions / organisations for academic development and research; Shall play role in framing of Board of Studies of all subjects; All Academic issues like admission, scholarship disbursement, issue of various certificates, etc., He will directly report to the Director and apprise the Director periodically on all academic issues.

Dean (Research)

All matters relating to PhD programmes shall be routed through the Dean (Research); Academic Collaboration with other institutions for planning, research, and development. Framing new Research Policy. Shall invite proposals both from the Faculty and Students. Augment internal resources; create more avenues for research.

Dean (Students Welfare)

Conduct of Election for Students Council; All students issues both in hostel and in the campus; arranging various events, i.e., Sports, Cultural and other events; various intercollege, Inter University, National and International events; Preparing students for participation in various National and International meets and events; maintaining harmony among students; redressal of grievances of the students on all matters.
