Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development (RGNIYD) is an Institute of National Importance by an Act of Parliament (35/2012) functioning under the Department of Youth Affairs, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India.

Applications are invited from the eligible candidates for engagement as Assistant Professor (on contract) with the following specialization:

ELIGIBILITY:**A).**

- I. Master 's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in a relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- II. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2018 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be. Provided further, candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances / Bye-laws / Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET subject to fulfilment of the following conditions: -
 - a) Awarded Ph.D. degree;
 - b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners;
 - c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
 - d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal;
 - e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conference/seminars, based on his/her Ph.D work.
 - f) (a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Registrar/ Dean (Academic Affairs).

- B). Ph.D degree from a University/Institution with a ranking in top 500 in the World University ranking (at any time) by Quacquarelli Symonds (QS), the Times Higher Education (THE) and Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. Application forms can be downloaded from the Institute website only (<https://www.rgniyd.gov.in/>).
2. Candidate should submit the duly filled prescribed application form along with self-attested copy of educational certificates, experience certificates, testimonials, etc. at the

time of Walk-in-Interview. Incomplete application without any supporting documents will be summarily rejected.

2. Original documents / certificates will have to be produced at the time of Walkin interview for verification.
3. Candidate will be allowed to attend the interview subject to the certificate verification and eligibility criteria.
4. Candidates are advised not to submit or send the hard copy of the application or any application-related documents to the Institute either by post or through email.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. Applications of candidates who do not fulfil the minimum eligibility criteria, including the requirement of "GOOD ACADEMIC RECORD," will be summarily rejected.
2. Mere fulfilment of the minimum eligibility criteria does not entitle any candidate to be called for an interview. The recommendations of the Certificate Verification Committee and the decision of the Competent Authority shall be final.
3. Short-listing/screening criteria may be set higher than the minimum advertised.
4. The number of posts indicated in this advertisement is tentative. The Institute reserves the right to fill consequential vacancies and/or to increase or decrease the number of posts and make appointments accordingly.
5. The Institute reserves the right to fill or not to fill any or all of the posts advertised, without assigning any reason whatsoever.
6. The selected candidates will be engaged purely on **temporary basis** for a period of **11 months** or one Academic Session i.e., 2026-27 whichever is earlier. This is subject to extension / curtailment depending upon the requirements and performance of the candidate. Under any circumstances, candidate cannot claim any right for permanent position / extension of contract.
7. Candidates may note that these contractual positions are intended to meet the immediate academic requirements of the Institute. Selection against these positions shall not confer any right or eligibility for regular recruitment or for being considered for regular posts in any future recruitment process.
8. Selected candidates will be paid a consolidated remuneration of **Rs. 52,000/- per month (Rupees Fifty-Two Thousand only)**, subject to applicable taxes. No other allowances shall be admissible.

9. Other terms and conditions of engagement shall be governed by the Statutes, Ordinances, rules, regulations and norms of RGNIYD, as amended from time to time, and as decided by the Competent Authority.
10. The candidate is responsible for the correctness and authenticity of the information furnished in the application. If, at any stage, any information furnished by the candidate is found to be incorrect, false or misleading, the candidature/appointment shall be liable to be cancelled/terminated.
11. RGNIYD reserves the right to summarily reject any application that is incomplete in any respect or is not accompanied by one or more of the prescribed enclosures/documents at the time of certificate verification.
12. A relieving order from the present/last employer shall be submitted at the time of joining, wherever applicable.
