DR. AMBEDKAR 132ND BIRTH ANNIVERSARY

SPECIAL LECTURE PROGRAMME 13th APRIL 2023

On April 13, 2023, the Centre for Dalit and Subaltern Studies of the RGNIYD organised a special lecture programme to honour Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, who tirelessly promoted social justice and believed that social justice is a way to build an ideal or just society based on the principles of liberty, equality, and fraternity. Every year, the Centre organizes a special invited lecture to commemorate Dr. B.R. Ambedkar's birth anniversary. The chief guest of year was, Dr. V.R.S. Sampath, who is a lawyer, Madras High Court, Editor of the law and human rights journal Sattakadir, and convener of the World Tamil Economic Forum. During the special lecture Programme Dr. V.R.S. Sampath gave a unique speech on Ambedkar's views on social justice for the occasion. In his speech, he emphasised Ambedkar's contributions to the upliftment of the oppressed and his tireless pursuit of social justice through the Indian Constitution. Prof. Sibnath Deb, Director, RGNIYD delivered his presidential remarks. In his speech, Professor Deb underlined the importance of sustaining social justice in our daily lives. He urged that every citizen must carry out their fundamental obligations. People occasionally forget their obligations while asserting their rights. He stated that social justice is an indication of progress of any society. He praised Dr. B.R. Ambedkar for his outstanding contributions to establishing a just society through constitutional means. The special lecture programme had 82 participants, including faculty, students, and nonteaching staff from RGNIYD, NSS series officers, and NSS volunteers from Sree Venkateshwara Engineering College in Sriperumbudur. Dr. S. Lalitha, Coordinator, Centre for Dalit and Subaltern Studies delivered welcome address in which she emphasized the objectives of the special lecture programme and the activities of Centre for Dalit and Subaltern Studies.
