**Report on**

**Observance of world bicycle day**

**3<sup>RD</sup> JUNE, 2022**

The RGNIYD, NER Centre functionaries (Coordinator and Training Associate) met Shri. Mama Natung, Hon'ble Minister Youth Affairs & Sports, Environment & Forest and Water Resources, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh on 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2022 in his chamber in the secretariat to invite him to the observance of World Environment day on 5<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 at Doimukh, Arunachal Pradesh. During the interaction the Minister advised them to participate in the observance of World Bicycle day on 3<sup>rd</sup> June, 2022 by NYK, Papum Pare district at Itanagar. Following his advice the NERC functionaries met the NYK DYC who formally requested the NER Centre to collaborate with the NYK. The Coordinator agreed to the proposal and subsequently got the permission from the RGNIYD administration. It was decided to provide one hundred water sachets to the cyclists and breakfast for the officials.

The NYK, Papum Pare District organised the World Bicycle Day, cyclothon on 3<sup>rd</sup> June, 2022 under the banner 'Fit India Movement' as part of celebrations of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahatosthav, in association with RGNIYD NER Centre, Department of Youth Affairs, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, Arunachal Cycling Association, Smart City Itanagar and National Service Scheme. The Coordinator and Training Associate around 5:30 am on 3<sup>rd</sup> June, 2022 and interacted with Shri.
