

Report of the Indian Foreign Policy Workshop (9-10th Feb, 2023)

The Department of Public Administration, Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development, Regional Centre, Chandigarh organised two-day workshop on Indian Foreign Policy on Crossroads: Changing World Scenario. Prof. Sibnath Deb, Director, RGNIYD gave the presidential address of the workshop, which was inaugurated by Prof Sanjay Kumar Bhardwaj, Centre for South Asian Studies, JNU, Delhi and Prof. Sharad Kumar Soni, Centre for Inner Asian Studies, School of International Studies, JNU, Delhi. On the first day, eminent Professors gave insights into various areas including India and South Asia, Decoding Inner Asia in India's Extended Neighborhood Policy, and Mapping India's (Re) connection to Central Asia.

Second day, Dr. Chet Ram, Director, Itihas Shodh Sansthan, Neri, Hamirpur, Himachal Pradesh discussed about the historical perspective of Indian Foreign Policy mainly from 17th century to 21st century and current. Dr Pooja Paswan, from Jamia Milia Islamia, Delhi, discussed the functions and India's theme of G20 Presidency – is “Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam” or “One Earth, One Family, One Future”.
